### **DISCLOSEABLE TRANSACTION DISPOSAL OF LISTED SECURITIES**

On 3 January 2013, the Company, through its wholly-owned subsidiary, disposed of 500,000 CMB Shares on the market for the aggregate gross sale proceeds of approximately HK\$8,872,600 (excluding transaction costs).

The Disposal constitutes a discloseable transaction of the Company as one of the applicable percentage ratios exceeds 5% but is less than 25%.

#### **THE DISPOSAL**

On 3 January 2013, the Company, through its wholly-owned subsidiary, disposed 500,000 CMB Shares on the market for the aggregate gross sale proceeds of approximately HK\$8,872,600 (excluding transaction costs).

As the Disposal was made on the market, the Company is not aware of the identities of the purchasers of the CMB Shares. To the best of the knowledge, information and belief of the Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, each of the purchasers of the CMB Shares and their ultimate beneficial owners are third parties independent of the Company and its connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules).

#### **Assets disposed**

The Group disposed of 500,000 CMB Shares, representing approximately 0.0023% of the issued share capital of CMB (based on the 21,576,608,885 CMB Shares as at 31 December 2012 according to publicly available information).

#### **Consideration**

The aggregate gross sale proceeds of the Disposal is approximately HK\$8,872,600 (excluding transaction costs), which is receivable in cash on settlement. The consideration for the Disposal represented the market price of the CMB Shares at the time of the Disposal.

## **REASONS FOR AND BENEFITS OF THE DISPOSAL**

The Group's principal businesses are property investments, garment sourcing and exporting businesses and investment in listed securities.

The purpose of the Disposal is to obtain a balanced securities investment portfolio. As a result of the Disposal, the Group is expected to recognize a gain of approximately HK\$568,000 which is calculated on the basis of the difference between the acquisition price and the disposal price (exclusive of the transaction costs). The Group intends to use the proceeds of the Disposal for general working capital.

The Disposal was made at market price and the Directors (including the independent non-executive Directors) are of the view that the Disposal will enhance the liquidity of the Company, was fair and reasonable, on normal commercial terms and in the interests of the Company and its Shareholders as a whole.

## **INFORMATION ON CMB**

According to publicly available information, CMB is a company incorporated in the PRC with limited liability and the H shares of which are listed on the main board of the Stock Exchange (Stock Code: 03968). According to its company profile made available on the internet, CMB provides corporate and personal banking services, conducts treasury business, provides asset management and trustee services and other financial services. Further information on CMB can be found on the website of the Stock Exchange. Based on the interim report of CMB for the six months ended 30 June 2012, the unaudited net asset value of CMB as at 30 June 2012 was RMB181,362 million. According to the annual reports of CMB for the two years ended 31 December 2010 and 31 December 2011 respectively, its net profits from ordinary activities before and after taxation were approximately RMB33,343 million and RMB25,769 million; and RMB47,122 million and RMB36,127 million respectively.

## **GENERAL**

The Disposal constitutes a discloseable transaction of the Company under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules, as one of the applicable percentage ratios exceeds 5% but is less than 25%.
