POLL RESULTS OF THE SGM

The Board is pleased to announce that all the proposed resolutions set out in the notice of the SGM to approve the S&P Agreement(s), the Capital Reorganisation, the Rights Issue and the transactions contemplated thereunder were duly passed by the Shareholders or the Independent Shareholders (as the case may be) at the SGM held on 7 October 2015 at 9:10 a.m. by way of poll.

As at the date of the SGM, the total number of issued Shares was 531,718,971 Shares, which was the total number of Shares entitling the holders to attend and vote for or against the special resolution numbered 2 at the SGM. There were no Share entitling the holders to attend and vote only against the special resolution numbered 2 proposed at the SGM. No Shareholder was required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the special resolution numbered 2 proposed at the SGM.

As stated in the Circular, the ordinary resolutions numbered 1 and 3 to approve the S&P Agreement(s), the Rights Issue and the transactions contemplated thereunder are subject to the approval of the Independent Shareholders by way of poll at the SGM. In accordance with the Listing Rules, Landmark Profits, Goodco and their respective associates have abstained from voting on the resolutions with regards to the approval of the S&P Agreement, the Rights Issue and the transactions contemplated thereunder at the SGM. As at the date of SGM, the number of Shares held by each of Landmark Profits, Goodco and their respective associates were 44,547,384 and 173,229,147 respectively, representing 8.38% and 32.58% of the issued share capital of the Company respectively. As such, the total number of Shares entitling the Independent Shareholders who were entitled to attend and vote for or against the ordinary resolutions numbered 1 and 3 was 313,942,440 Shares. There were no Share entitling the holders to attend and vote only against the ordinary resolutions numbered 1 and 3 proposed at the SGM.

Save as disclosed above, no party has stated its intention in the Circular to vote against or to abstain from voting on the resolutions proposed at the SGM.
